### **A11 works – Fiveways roundabout**

Highways England operates, maintains and modernises the strategic road network in the East of England. We are committed to making journeys more reliable and ensuring that the region's roads are fit for now and for the future.

We are pleased to inform you that the following works are due to start shortly.

- Installation of traffic signal heads, road signs, traffic sensing loops, hard standings for speed enforcement and road lining

The work is planned to start on **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018** and is programmed to take approximately **9 weeks** (see separate works areas attached to this letter). **Please note that these works are subject to weather conditions and dates may change, notices onsite will provide the most up to date information.** Should there be a requirement to significantly re-programme the work further notification will be issued.

These road improvements are necessary to maintain the strategic road network along the A11. This will add benefits such as safety improvements, easier exiting on to the roundabout from the surrounding villages and an improved journey for our customers.

### **Traffic restrictions**

**We are aware the affect traffic disruption has on our customers and the local community** and will only be diverting traffic onto local roads when absolutely necessary. Where we do need to close the A11 and divert traffic, we closely consult with the local authority to agree the most appropriate route and timings. There may be times on this scheme when no visible works are taking place.

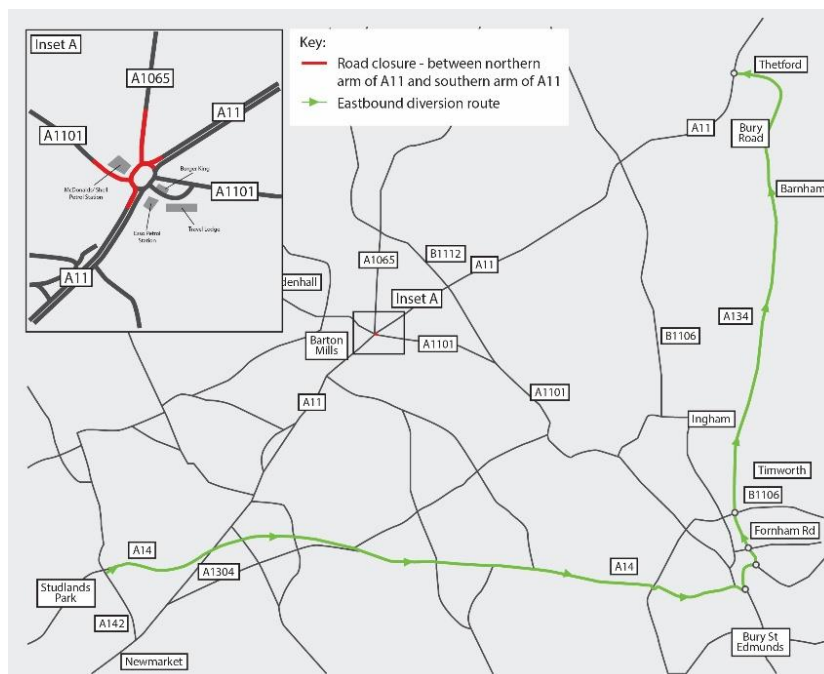
The following road closures will be in place between **8pm** and **6am** on **weekdays** only.

### **Monday 10 September occasional weeknights only:**

Overnight lane closures of the A11

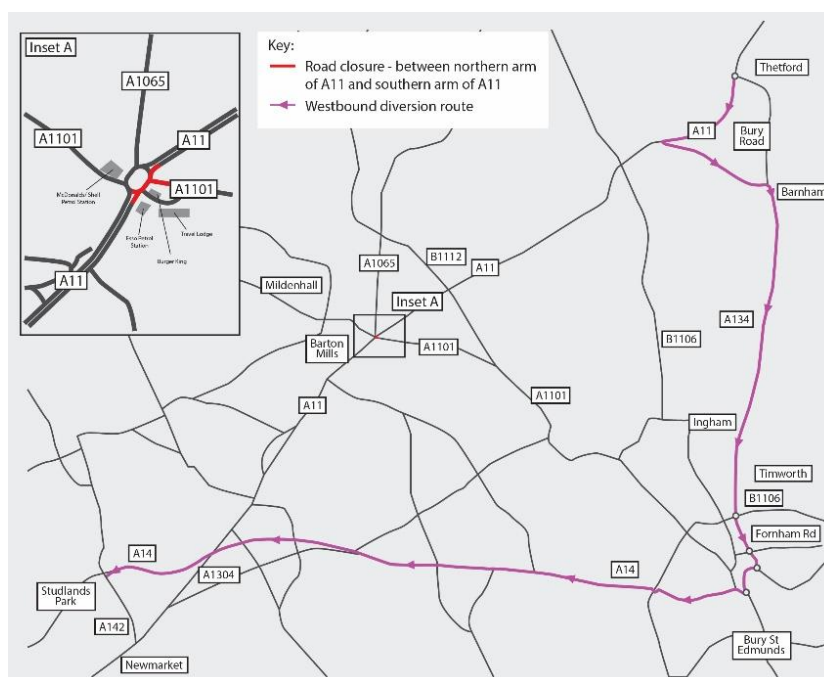
**Thursday 20 September for 10 weeknights and Monday 29 October for 5 weeknights:**

The A11 northbound will be closed at the A14 and a clearly signed diversion will be in place via A14 and A134 towards Thetford.



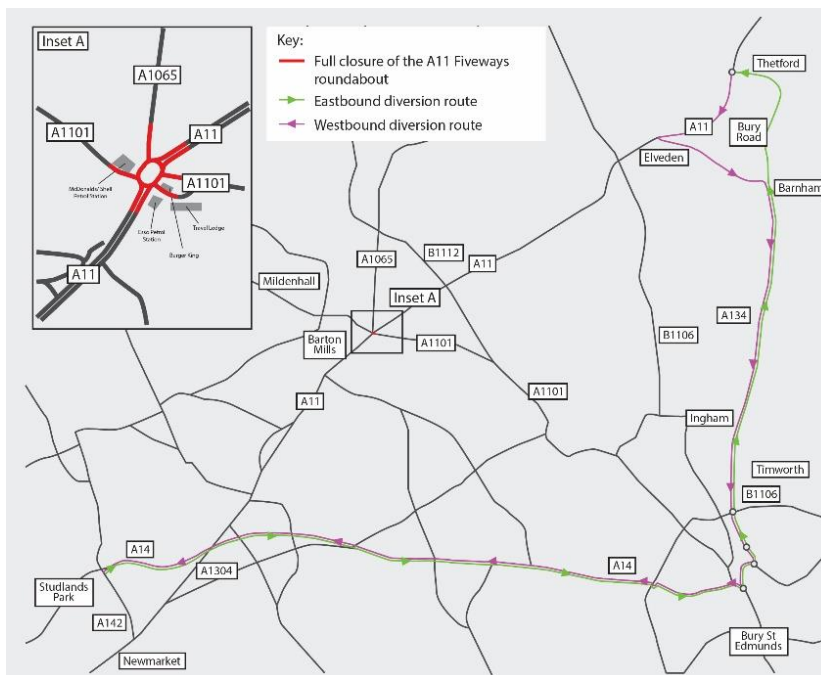
**Monday 22 October for 5 weeknights:**

The A11 southbound will be closed at Elveden and a clearly signed diversion will be in place via Elveden Road, A134 and A14.



## Friday 9 November for 1 night:

Total closure of the Fiveways roundabout and a clearly signed diversion for A11 northbound traffic will be in place via A14 and A134. The A11 southbound will be closed at Elveden and a clearly signed diversion will be in place via Elveden Road, A134 and A14.



## Access and disruption

Access for emergency vehicles will be allowed at all times.

Due to the nature of the works being carried out noise and light disturbance is unavoidable. We will however attempt to keep this to a minimum. Please accept our apologies in advance of any inconvenience that is caused whilst work is in progress.

## Safety

Your safety is important to us, as is the safety of our operatives working on site. We would be grateful if you could observe signs and restrictions in place as any unauthorised access to the site creates a serious risk to safety of everyone involved.
